- Circumcision (as long as it is done at birth) (SCH Service)

- Electrocardiogram (EKG) (SCH Medical Service)
- Fluoroscopy (SCH Medical Service)
- Insertion of IUD
- Mammogram (SCH Medical Service)
- Pap Smear (SCH Medical Service)
- Tubal Ligation
- Ultrasound (Also called Doppler studies) (SCH Medical Service)
- Vasectomy
- X-rays (SCH Medical Service)

You are required to obtain authorization for certain procedures that might be cosmetic or not medically necessary for the treatment of illness or injury. All requests for these procedures should be made in writing and should be submitted well in advance of the planned procedure date:

- Blephareplasty
- Breast reduction or Mammoplasty
- Dermatolipectomy
- Diastasis recti repair (tummy tuck)
- Hernia repairs, all except inguinal (SCH Medical Service)
- Incision of the maxilla or mandible
- Keloid removal
- Mastectomy for gynecomastia
- Mentoplasty
- Otoplasty
- Panniculectomy (SCH Medical Service)
- Rhinoplasty
- Sclerotherapy
